

## Co-chairs' summary sets out areas of convergence...


- Value of a voluntary, multisectoral and multi-stakeholder approach to mobilize all actors
- Need for complementarity, avoid duplication
- Linkage to the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development
- Key points related to governance, new and emerging issues, science-policy interface, financing and national implementation.
- Co-chairs' summary to be elaborated in preparation for the second intersessional meeting, with stakeholder input
- Meeting report is being finalized, captures the discussions



## Intersessional work


- Secretariat was requested to develop a set of intersessional papers, in consultation with the ICCM5 Bureau, linked to:
  - Governance
  - Sustainable Development Goals / proposal on objectives
  - Financing
  - Gender
- SAICM independent evaluation 2006-2015 is underway, to be finalized for OEWG3
- Invite all stakeholders to get involved and provide input
