Face-to-face meeting considerations

- 1. Health and safety of participants and staff servicing the meeting
- 2. National controls on public gatherings in the host country
- 3. Border closures or restrictions in the host country and the countries of meeting participants
- 4. Transport limitations or costs, particularly air transport
- 5. Liability in the event that sponsored delegates are 'trapped' during travel to, or at, the meeting venue



Online meeting challenges

- 1. Tools and platforms: their capabilities and restrictions
 - Ease of use
 - Security
 - Participation limits
 - Universal accessibility
 - Interpretation needs
- 2. Rules of procedure
- 3. Decision-making protocols
- 4. Costs for participants
