- Virtual **Working Groups**
 - Representative of Regions and Sectors
 - Plan adequate time to identify representatives
- Virtual **Technical Briefings**
 - Replicate 2x
 - Include stakeholders as hosts and co-organizers
 - Challenge: webinar overload
- Keep **SAICM website** updated

Other Suggestions:

- **ICCM5 High-level Declaration**
 - Getting started
 - Plan adequate time to identify representatives
 - Include Dubai Declaration (“SAICM 1.0”), still relevant

- **UNEA5 (Feb 2021)**
 - Opportunity for Ministerial Declaration
& Resolution on Chemicals and Waste
 - E.g.: financing, supplementing Special Programme
