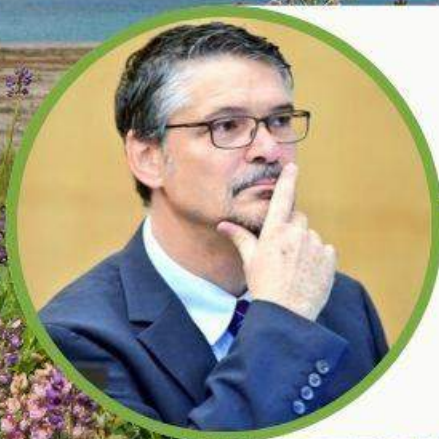

SBI-3 Expectations for Resumed Meeting

- Important to finish SBI3's mandate as mandated by COP14 and COP/MoPs of the Protocols
- Continue the work started at the first session – pick up where we left off. Discussion of CRPs and formally adopt L-docs;
- Resume first reading on agenda item 8, Cooperation. Also consider new docs based on intersessional work
- Continue with Contact groups (Resource mobilization, Review mechanism, Capacity building, Gender plan of Action, Cartagena Protocol Implementation Plan)
- L documents : use informal processes for advancing consensus on outstanding issues to remove brackets
- Although not preferred, draft decision in L-document, in places of great divergence, may be adopted with brackets for further consideration at COP15, COP/MOP 10 and COP/MOP 4

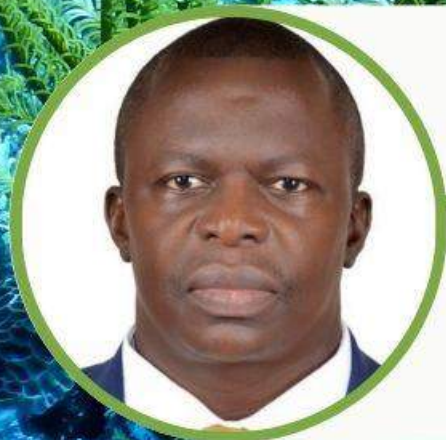

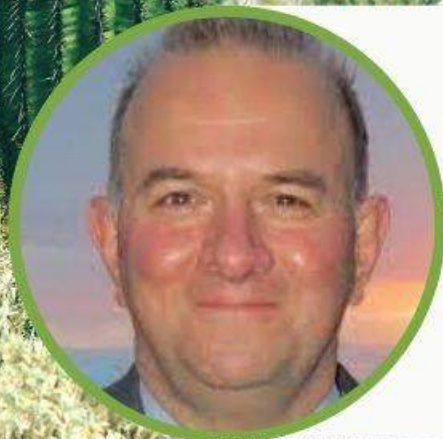
Linkages: Post-2020 GBF and SBI

- Several SBI agenda items are directly linked to the post-2020 global biodiversity framework – clearly indicated in the different mandates for the agenda items
- After the first virtual session – the outcome of the meeting was given to the Post 2020-co-chairs so that they could take it into account in preparation for first draft
- Parties will have to decide what elements (or level of details) is needed in GBF as part of the WG2020 deliberation
- SBI and WG2020 will continue to have close coordination


