



Some dates:

• 5 - 9 June 2017:

The First United Nations Conference on the Oceans (UNOC) took place in New York, in which Portugal and Singapore had the roles of co-facilitators of the adopted political document - Our ocean, our future: call for action.

At the time, Portugal and Kenya announced their readiness to host the II UNOC.

The two countries agreed that they'd both co-host the II UNOC in Lisbon and Portugal would support the High-Level Conference on the Sustainable Blue Economy held in Nairobi in 2018.

• 9 September 2019

The United Nations General Assembly adopted Resolution No. 73/292 establishing that UNOC would be held in Lisbon between 2 and 6 June 2020 and describing the conceptual framework, substantive objectives and organisation procedures.

• 13 April 2020

Decision 74/548 of the UNGA postponed UNOC.

• 8 September 2021

Decision No. 75/578 of the AGNU resumes the process and establishes that UNOC will be held in Lisbon between June 27 and July 1, 2022, also updating the tasks and dates of the preparatory process.


Resolution 73 / 292 reminds:

- That the SDGs are integrated, indivisible and balance the three dimensions of sustainable development: economic, social and environmental;
- The importance of conservation and sustainable use of seas and marine resources to achieve the SDG and SD Agenda 2030 as a whole.






- Promotion of Sustainable Development Goal 14:

Substantive goals


Resolution No. 73/292 establishes that UNOC will approve, by consensus:

- A short, concise, action-oriented, negotiated declaration between governments that highlights innovative, science-based areas of action that support the achievement of SDG 14;
- A report with summaries prepared by the cochairs of the Interactive Dialogues;
- A list of voluntary commitments for the pursuit of SDG 14, registered after 09.06.2017 and announced at UNOC.
