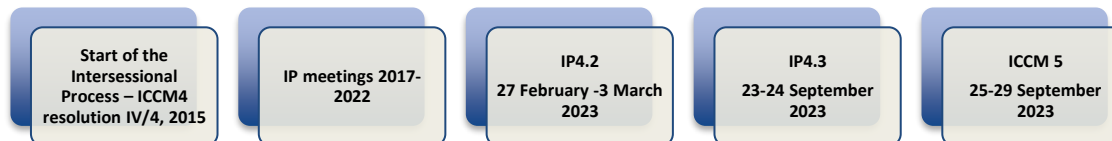
The delegates welcomed the revised **consolidated text presented** on Friday 3 March 2023 as a significant achievement but agreed to the IP Co-Chairs proposal to **re-adjourn the Intersessional Process Meeting and reconvene two days before ICCM5 in Bonn, Germany on 23 and 24 September 2023**, to finalize the Intersessional Process work.

ICCM5

- The fifth session of the International Conference for Chemicals Management (ICCM 5) and its high-level segment will take place in Bonn between 25- 29 September 2023. There will be two days of a resumed IP4 meeting just prior to ICCM5 and regional meetings on 21 and 22 September.
- Capacity building, stocktaking, and measurability structure appear within reach during discussion in Bonn in September 2023 to adopt the global framework instrument.
- Significant work will be required on targets and financial considerations, still filled with bracketed text, to reach consensus.

BEYOND 2020 FRAMEWORK INSTRUMENT

Is expected to:

- Provide the framework instrument for chemicals and waste pillar of planetary crisis through a unique multi-stakeholder and multi-sectoral engagement. It holds significant potential in scaling up collective and whole of society actions reaching out to key sectoral ministries beyond environment ones.
- It is also conceived to bring in circular approaches, lifecycle thinking, and benefits valuable to other agendas such as biodiversity, climate, human rights.
- Create an opportunity and incentives for enhanced action and engagement of key stakeholders in key economic industry sectors and value chains by stimulating action within and across sectors, in companies, groups of companies, and through associations.
- Mobilize adequate and innovative financing on the road to transformation for greener, cleaner and more sustainable solutions.

ICCM 5 High-Level Segment

- High-Level Segment of the fifth session of the International Conference on Chemicals Management (ICCM5) will take place 28 - 29 of September 2023 at the World Conference Centre in Bonn, Germany.
- The High-Level Segment will lay the political foundation for ambitious commitments to address global chemicals and waste impacts in the context of the complex challenges of our time.
- In recognition of the multi-sectoral relevance of global chemicals and waste management, high level participants from all stakeholders and sectors, including but not limited to agriculture, development, environment, foreign affairs, health, industry, and labour will be welcome.
- Important expected outcomes of the High-Level Segment include a High-Level Declaration, as well as stakeholder pledges, commitments and partnerships to implement the new framework instrument.
- Thematic Roundtables will feature dialogues among high-level stakeholders on important aspects of implementing the new framework instrument and High-Level Declaration.

ICCM5 and IP4.3 logistic information

has *not* been met in large part to the lack of resources for its implementation

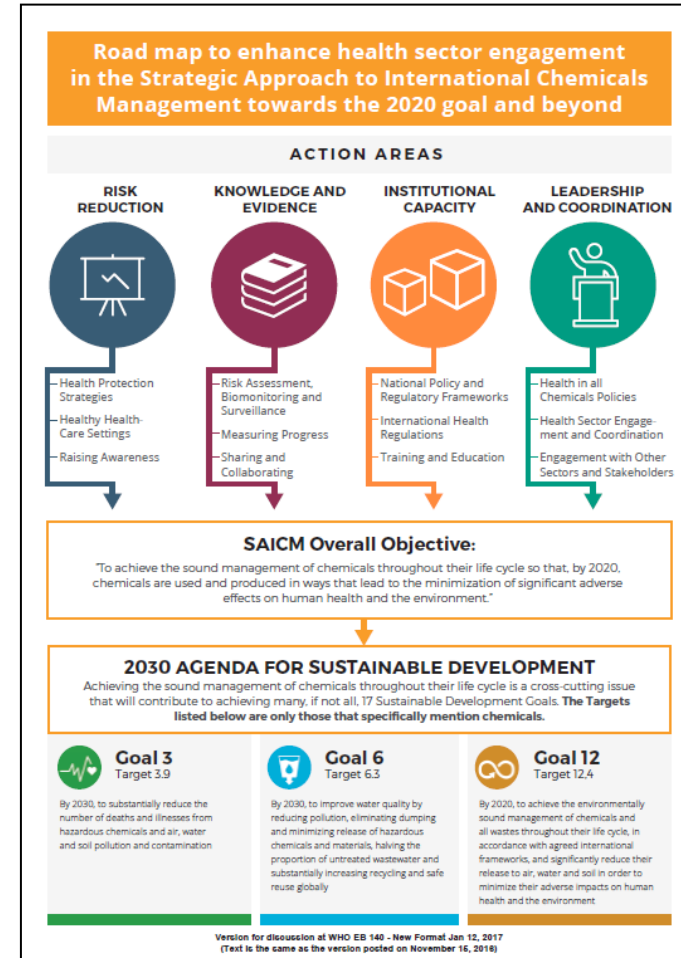
SAICM Health Sector Strategy for strengthening the engagement of the health sector in the implementation of SAICM, 2013

- emphasizes the need to fully engage the health sector
- encourages the health sector to take full advantage of SAICM arrangements
- recognizes the importance of regional health & environment ministerial processes as springboards for effective inter-sectoral action
- calls upon the health sector to actively participate in actions to implement ICCM decisions with respect of identified emerging policy issues

World Health Assembly requests WHO Roadmap:

... in consultation with Member States and other relevant stakeholders, a road map outlining concrete actions to enhance health sector engagement towards meeting the 2020 goal and contributing to relevant targets of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

The impact of chemicals, waste and pollution on human health WHAA76 2023

- Cosponsors: Canada, Colombia, Ecuador, European Union and its Member States, Mexico, Monaco, Peru, Switzerland and Uruguay
 - **(1) strengthen** implementation of the WHO Global Strategy on Health, Environment and Climate and the WHO Road Map to enhance the engagement of the health sector in the Strategic Approach to International Chemicals Management towards the 2020 goal and beyond, taking a health-in-all policies approach;
 - **(2) support** WHO in scaling up work on plastics and health to enable better information of the potential human health impacts associated with plastic, including plastic pollution, with the aim of strengthening the public health aspects,
 - **(3) encourage** the health sector to strengthen partnerships and collaborative efforts to develop and update regulatory frameworks, including the harmonization of protocols for national human biomonitoring and surveillance programmes particularly for chemicals of concern such as cadmium, lead, mercury, highly hazardous pesticides and endocrine disrupting chemicals (EDCs);

WHA (cont)

- 4) further explore, recognize and act on the linkages between chemicals, waste and pollution and other health priorities at the domestic and international levels, such as maternal and child health, antimicrobial resistance, and the importance of identifying, preventing and addressing environmentally related disease in Universal Health Coverage;
- (5) engage in the ad hoc open-ended working group established by United Nations Environment Assembly decision 5/8 to prepare proposals for the *science-policy panel* to contribute further to the sound management of chemicals and waste and prevent pollution, particularly with regard to inclusion of health aspects and participation of the health sector in the eventual panel;
- (6) recognize the importance of science-based domestic regulation of highly hazardous pesticides, in efforts to reduce adverse occupational health effects, exposure of children, and the consequences of highly hazardous pesticides on human health and diseases, including to address suicide and neurological disorders

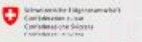
