ICCM5 President: "While more work is needed, I feel stimulated by this "Nairobi spirit" and more than ever I am convinced that collectively we will create a powerful international framework that further generates multisectoral and stakeholder commitment and collaboration to deliver concrete action integrated across sectors and value chains"

The delegates welcomed the revised consolidated text presented on Friday 3 March 2023 as a significant achievement but agreed to the IP Co-Chairs proposal to re-adjourn the Intersessional Process Meeting and reconvene two days before ICCM5 in Bonn, Germany on 23 and 24 September 2023, to finalize the Intersessional Process work.



INTERSESSIONAL PROCESS CONSIDERING THE STRATEGIC APPROACH AND SOUND MANAGEMENT OF CHEMICALS AND WASTE BEYOND 2020





ICCM5

- The fifth session of the International Conference for Chemicals Management (ICCM 5) and its high-level segment will take place In Bonn between 25- 29 September 2023. There will be two days of a resumed IP4 meeting just prior to ICCM5 and regional meetings on 21 and 22 September.
- Capacity building, stocktaking, and measurability structure appear within reach during discussion in Bonn in September 2023 to adopt the global framework instrument.
- Significant work will be required on targets and financial considerations, still filled with bracketed text, to reach consensus.
- These are the two areas in the "Beyond 2020" framework instrument where ambition is needed and can have the most impact. ICCM5 information and meeting documents are available at ICCM5 website: <u>Fifth session of the International</u> <u>Conference for Chemicals Management (ICCM5) | SAICM</u>.

BEYOND 2020 FRAMEWORK INSTRUMENT

Is expected to:

- Provide the framework instrument for chemicals and waste pillar of planetary crisis through a unique multi-stakeholder and multi-sectoral engagement. It holds significant potential in scaling up collective and whole of society actions reaching out to key sectoral ministries beyond environment ones.
- It is also conceived to bring in circular approaches, lifecycle thinking, and benefits valuable to other agendas such as biodiversity, climate, human rights.
- Create an opportunity and incentives for enhanced action and engagement of key stakeholders in key economic industry sectors and value chains by stimulating action within and across sectors, in companies, groups of companies, and through associations.
- Mobilize adequate and innovative financing on the road to transformation for greener, cleaner and more sustainable solutions.



ICCM 5 High-Level Segment

- High-Level Segment of the fifth session of the International Conference on Chemicals Management (ICCM5) will take place 28 29 of September 2023 at the World Conference Centre in Bonn, Germany.
- The High-Level Segment will lay the political foundation for ambitious commitments to address global chemicals and waste impacts in the context of the complex challenges of our time.
- In recognition of the multi-sectoral relevance of global chemicals and waste management, high level participants from all stakeholders and sectors, including but not limited to agriculture, development, environment, foreign affairs, health, industry, and labour will be welcome.
- Important expected outcomes of the High-Level Segment include a High-Level Declaration, as well as stakeholder pledges, commitments and partnerships to implement the new framework instrument.
- Thematic Roundtables will feature dialogues among high-level stakeholders on important aspects of implementing the new framework instrument and High-Level Declaration.

Consultations ahead of IP4.3 and ICCM5 meetings



- On 22-23 June 2023, the ICCM5 Bureau agreed that the Co-Chairs, in cooperation with co-facilitators and the secretariat, develop non-papers. The non-papers aim to propose text to facilitate the achievement of consensus at IP4.3.
- The following non-papers were published on 11 August 2023 on the SAICM website: <u>Fourth Intersessional meeting</u> (saicm.org):
 - Non-paper on Strategic Objectives and Targets,
 - Non-paper on Financial considerations, Financial Arrangements and Capacity Building,
 - Non-paper on Measurability structure.
- The IP4 consolidated document that remains the basis of discussion at the resumed IP4 meeting in Bonn is available as a stand-alone document (SAICM/IP.4/12), together with other IP4 documents at the SAICM webpage: <u>Fourth Intersessional</u> <u>meeting (saicm.org</u>).



ICCM5 and IP4.3 logistic information

- Registration status: as of 22 August 2023, we have received almost 520 registrations for the regional, IP4.3 and ICCM5 meetings, with around 50% of registrations coming from the governmental sector.
- An explanatory video has been produced by the SAICM Secretariat to support ICCM5 credentials, accreditations and visa processes. It is available at the ICCM5 website: <u>Fifth session of the International Conference for Chemicals</u> <u>Management (ICCM5) | SAICM</u>
- The Secretariat and the ICCM5 Presidency completed the process for identifying ICCM5 exhibitions and informed the selected stakeholders accordingly.
- Due to the large number of requests received to hold a side event during ICCM5, and the limited number of slots available, the SAICM Secretariat is getting back to those stakeholders, who submitted their requests, during the week of 21 August 2023.







- Cosponsors: Canada, Colombia, Ecuador, European Union and its Member States, Mexico, Monaco, Peru, Switzerland and Uruguay
 - (1) strengthen implementation of the WHO Global Strategy on Health, Environment and Climate and the WHO Road Map to enhance the engagement of the health sector in the Strategic Approach to International Chemicals Management towards the 2020 goal and beyond, taking a health-in-all policies approach;
 - (2) support WHO in scaling up work on plastics and health to enable better information of the potential human health impacts associated with plastic, including plastic pollution, with the aim of strengthening the public health aspects,

 (6) recognize the importance of science-based domestic regulation of highly hazardous pesticides, in efforts to reduce adverse occupational health effects, exposure of children, and the consequences of highly hazardous pesticides on human health and diseases, including to address suicide and neurological disorders
