At the 77th World Health Assembly, Members States will consider a resolution on climate change and health which is a building block towards integrated action on climate and health. The resolution will complement the General Comment 26 of the Committee on the Rights of the Child (GC26) and the COP28 Declaration on climate and health. This side event will demonstrate how to translate these policies into implementation at national and local level with the support of finance, and mainstreaming a child rights and child sensitive approach.
